Dear Parents,

I know it is only a week since my last newsletter but I thought I would update you on what is happening in school, especially regarding class 3.

We have all been a little taken aback by the news that Mrs Haddon is un-well; however she is now out of hospital and is continuing to make a steady recovery. She has been overwhelmed by the cards, flowers and best wishes she has received and would like to say a big thank you for your generosity and kindness.

I have been able to get a supply teacher who is able to cover the majority of the time that potentially Mrs Haddon will be away from school for. Her name is Mrs Beverley Andersen. She has a wealth of experience and has worked in similar schools to ours for the last few years. She starts with us on Tuesday 8th March and apart from Monday 7th, Friday 11th and the morning of Thursday 10th March (when either Mrs Simpson or I will take the class) she will be teaching class 3.
